Excursion 04: “TOUR OF TARSHISH” – FULL DAY

TOUR OF GALLE WITH KOSGODA & MEETIYAGODA VISIT



Morning pick up from hotel and proceed to Galle for city tour which will be followed up Lunch at a local restaurant and then on the return journey visit a Turtle hatchery as well as to Meetiyagoda moonstone mines.

GALLE - South Coast's major city is Galle, whose oldest landmark is the massive Portuguese and Dutch Fort which is a “World Heritage Site” in which the central city is contained. But the city may be much older. Some scholars believe it to be the “Tarshish” of the Old Testament, to which King Solomon sent his merchant vessels, and to which Jonah fled from the Lord. Today, the 90-acre Galle Fort shows no evidence of the Portuguese founders. The Dutch incorporated the Portuguese northern wall in a great rampart in 1663. **KOSGODA TURTLE HATCHERY** - Where you can see five species of turtles-Green Turtles (*Chelonia mydas*), Hawksbill Turtle (*Eretmochelys imbricata*), Loggerhead Turtle (*Caretta caretta*), Leatherback Turtle (*Dermochelys coriacea*) and Olive Ridley Turtle (*Lepidochelys olivacea*). **THE MOONSTONE MINES AT MEETIYAGODA** - One of the best-known primary gem deposits in Sri Lanka is the large pegmatite vein of moonstone at Meetiyagoda, a small village a few miles from the coast in the south-west of the island.

Excursion 05: “CEYLON TEA” – FULL DAY TOUR OF GALLE WITH HANDUNAGODA & MAADU RIVER CRUISE



Morning pick up from hotel and visit Handunagoda Tea Factory followed by a visit to Galle Dutch Fort and then on the return leg of the journey do a boat ride at Maadu River.

HUNDUNGODA TEA FACTORY - The visitors are given

individual attention and are taken round the estate by experienced guides with a thorough knowledge of English. The process of harvesting, plucking of the Virgin white tea is demonstrated and a comprehensive explanation is given on the culture of tea. A plantation visit takes approximately 45 minutes to 1 hour. All visitors are given an opportunity to taste the tea produced. **BOAT RIDE - MADU GANGA RIVER**



is a shallow water body in south-west Sri Lanka, which enters the sea at Balapitiya. Together with the smaller Randonbe Lake, to which it is connected by two narrow channels, it forms the Madu Ganga wetland. Its estuary and the many mangrove islets on it constitute a complex coastal wetland ecosystem. It has high ecological, biological and aesthetic significance, being home to 303 species of plants belonging to 95 families and to 248 species of vertebrate animals. Madu Ganga is possibly one of the last remaining tracts of pristine mangrove forests in Sri Lanka.

Excursion 06: “SACRED CITY IN THE HIGHLANDS OF SRI LANKA” - FULL DAY TOUR TO KANDY



Morning pick up from hotel and proceed to Pinnawela and visit the Elephant orphanage and then proceed to Kandy in time for Lunch and on completion do a city tour with visit to the temple of the sacred tooth relic before continuing back to Negombo.

PINNAWELA ELEPHANT ORPHANAGE - off the Colombo - Kandy road is Pinnawela, where an orphanage was started in 1975 to house the abandoned and the wounded elephants. The number of elephants has increased to more than 65 now; including Baby Elephants brought from various parts, as well as some of the more than 25 babies born, as a result of the captive breeding programme. The best time to visit is the feeding times and the bathing times when all the elephants are taken to the river close by.

KANDY - the hill capital is another “World Heritage Site”. It was the last stronghold of the Sinhalese Kings during the Portuguese, Dutch and British rule and finally ceded to the British after an agreement. To the Buddhist of Sri Lanka

and the World, Kandy is one of the most sacred sites as it is the home of the “Dalada Maligawa” - Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic of Lord Buddha. Close by are the remains of the Royal Palace (Maha Wasala), Palle Wasala, where the Queens stayed and is now used for the National Museum, Meda Wasala where other close relatives lived, Audience Hall, Natha Devala and Vishnu Devala are situated. The Bathing Pavilion (Ulpenge) is by the Lake and in the Center of the lake is the Island called “Kiri samudraya” (Milk white ocean) used by the kings as the summerhouse.



**WHAT TO WEAR**

Most travelers tend to bring too many clothes in general, and too many thick clothes in particular. In the heat and humidity of the lowlands, cotton and light natural fabrics such as linen are ideal for women during the day. However, remember that Sri Lanka is a conservative culture, so skimpy skirts and brief shorts are not considered respectable. During the evening it is advisable to wear lightweight long sleeved tops and trousers to provide some protection against mosquitoes. Women should pack a long dress or skirt and long-sleeved blouse for visiting places of worship.
